I don't understand how motorola can design a PTT Google driven android and not give you the ability to import PTT contacts. Am I missing something or is it impossible to import direct conr contacts? I have tried several ways to do this and all have failed. My contacts in outlook use radio field which exports to gmail fine but then imports to the i1 as the radio field, failing to pop the PTT 1 field. I've tried creating an outlook field called PTT 1 but this doesn't populate the P field on the i1 it just creates a new phone field called PTT 1. 😞 Any ideas would be greatly appreciated.

PTT1_Primary

I used the old SIM card from my i465, the i1 imported all the contacts from the SIM card without problem. I then created a gmail account and then the i1 saved all my contact numbers to gmail
